






Khrunichev State Research and Production Center, Russia in Space

Hong Yuen Electronics Ltd., of China Aerospace International Holding Limited (CASIL) received the B.I.D. Ouality Summit Award in New York



The Burj Khalifa tower, (also known as the Burj Dubai) was completed in 2009 and officially opened on January 4, 2010. It stands 828 meters tall - just over half a mile. That's nearly 300 meters taller than the previously tallest floored building in the world, the Taipei Tower in Taiwan. Outside, the 'Dubai Fountain', designed by WET Design is illuminated by 6,600 lights and 50 colored projectors, setting a record of its own through its jetstream shooting water 150 meters into the air. The tallest man-made structure, the Burj Khalifa's budget was approximately \$4.1 billion USD. Turner Construction, which managed construction of the tower, works with around 1,600 projects per year. 5,000 employees worldwide and 46 offices in the U.S.

With a construction volume of \$ 8 billion USD, it specializes in construction management, consulting, contracting, and insurance and risk management.
